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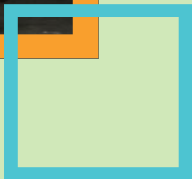
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AN OVERVIEW





DOKUZ EYLÜL UNIVERSITY OVERVIEW

Dokuz Eylül University which aims to undertake the mission of “increasing the economic, socio-cultural richness through its education and scientific research” it does commits itself to the goal “to become one of the best education and science centers in the world”, which makes up its vision as well. Carrying out its educational activities with such commitment, Dokuz Eylül University has taken its place among the greatest and rooted universities in Turkey.

In the belief that Turkish Republic is a democratic, secular, social state, under the guidance of Atatürk's principles and reforms, Dokuz Eylül University aims a bright future, with a qualified and contemporary education as well as human and social values which in turn makes it to reach a privileged position among universities in Turkey.

Our university, which was founded in accordance with the “Executive Order concerning Higher Education Institutions” no 41 published in the official gazette on 20th of July 1982, in İzmir, the third largest city and a window opening to the west, has entered into the process of growing rapidly as the second state university in İzmir after Ege University.

As of the academic years 2015–2016, our university has carried out its educational activities on various campuses located at **Buca** (Tınaztepe, Center, Dokuzçeşmeler), **Balçova**, **İnciraltı**, **Alsancak**, **Narlıdere**, **Hatay**, **Urla**, **Seferihisar**, **Karşıyaka**, **Foça**, **Torbalı**, **Bergama**



and **Selçuk** with a total area of **5.731.800 m²**. Our university lives the unique identity and dynamic spirit of the city with its campuses across the city in different locations and is a big educational institution where **71.356 students who come to study all across Turkey and 1.544 international students from 126 countries**. Dokuz Eylül University has a colorful fabric with its diversity and number of students and has 165 student clubs and societies, 42 of which are directly affiliated with the Rectorate and provides students with the environment and opportunities needed for cultural, artistic, and athletic activities of our students.

Dokuz Eylül University decided to establish a technology development zone where universities, research labs, and industrial enterprises develop scientific, technological, and R&D projects all together in one place and took action in this direction by setting up **DEPARK (Dokuz Eylül Technology Development Zone)** in accordance with the decree no 2012/4085 published in the Official Gazette on 3rd of January 2013. Thus, as a part of **DEPARK**, a multi-purpose technopark was established in an area of 17.413 m² on Tınaztepe campus and another “Biomedical Technopark” was established in an area of 10.487 m² on the medical campus. Both technoparks have started their scientific activities ever since and moved forward with the same energy of day one.



Our university is going in the right direction of being under limelight when it comes to scientific research in Turkey with these establishments that are welcomed with excitement in the scientific world. DEPARK; in Alfa and Beta buildings at Tınaztepe campus and “Zeytin Binası” (Olive Building) which is on our medical campus where one of the best university hospitals in Turkey even in the world, accelerated their studies with their qualified faculty members and technical equipment.

In the direction of our university’s top priorities in our strategic plan, Advanced Biomedical Research and Development Center was established as a result of our desire to add one of the world’s most advanced R&D centers to our structure and later it led scientific efforts under the name of **IBG (Izmir Biomedicine and Genome Institution)**. “**International İzmir Biomedicine and Genome Institution**” was officially founded in accordance with the decree no 29290 published in the Official Gazette on 9th of March 2015 with the approval of Council of Higher Education, the Ministry of National Education and Council of Ministers upon the application of our university’s Senate to turn the Center into an institution. IBG continues its activities such as “cellular therapy”, “cancer biology”, “development of biosimilar and biomolecules”, and “DNA biobank”. IBG moves confidently also to the goal of making İzmir a **Brand City in Science** beside our university.



Our university is a big education establishment that consists of 91 units including 14 faculties (**Buca Education, Maritime, Faculty of Letters, Science, Fine Arts, Nursery, Law School, Economics and Administrative Sciences, Theology, Business, Architecture, Engineering, Medical School and Tourism**), 10 institutes, 1 conservatory, 4 schools, 6 vocational schools, 56 research and application centers as well as DEPARK. As of 2016, our university employs 3.227 academic and 3.204 administrative staff.

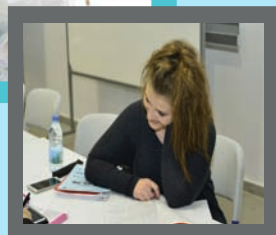
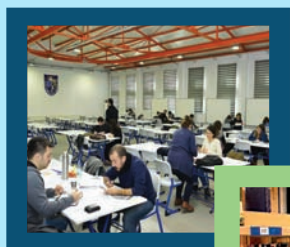

EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM OF DOKUZ EYLÜL UNIVERSITY





GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM

Registration Information

The candidates who have settled in our university will be able to register in two ways such as electronic registration method through e-government (e-devlet) (www.turkiye.gov.tr) or web registration method through our university web site (www.deu.edu.tr). Instructions about how to register will be sent to each candidate address given to the Student Selection and Placement Centre (ÖSYM) by themselves. In addition, information about the registration process will be announced on the university web page. Candidates who prefer the electronic method of registration complete their registration procedure by delivering their required documents to the associated Faculty/Schools personally at places and on dates specified by the Faculty, after they do the “DEBIS input” step of registration process on our web page. There is no registration by mail or incomplete documents.

Candidates who prefer the electronic method of registration can do their course registration if only they have delivered the documents requested by our departments on the announced dates.

Moreover, the evening education program students who registered through electronic method are required to pay tuition fees before the course registration process.

University's academic year starts on the dates specified in the academic calendar of 2015- 2016.

Required Documents for the Final Registration

1. Original diploma or new-dated graduation certificate received from secondary education institution. (Achievement Certificate doesn't take graduation certificate's place)
2. The conscription status of candidates enrolled through ÖSYS (Measuring, Selection and Placement System) can be viewed on the website kamu.turkiye.gov.tr. Candidates need to consult at recruiting offices of the Turkish Armed Forces about issues regarding their conscription statuses.
3. 12 new-dated portraits (4,5x6 cm)
4. Health certificate (for the Departments/Programmes defined in ÖSYS guide)
5. Receipt of tuition payment (For the evening education)

The candidates whose registration process is not completed between the given dates can't make any claims.

Required Documents for Final Registration of International Diploma Students

The following documents are required for registration of students accepted by "International Students Acceptance Examination" (DEYOS):

1. The original of high school diploma or temporary certificate,
2. Diploma or equivalency certificate confirmed from the Ministry of Education, Provincial National Education Directorates or Foreign Representative,
3. Education visa
4. Bank statement showing the payment of the tuition,
5. 6 piece (4.5 x 6 cm size), colored portrait photographs,
6. If available, Turkish proficiency certificate,
7. Foreign language proficiency certificate, for the applicants to the programmes taught through a foreign language,
8. A document that shows proof of adequate financial means to support a living in Turkey
9. Medical report should be taken in accordance with specified conditions related to the Department.
10. Residence Permit
11. Copy of the expatriation permit for those who are Turkish citizens by birth and have

received expatriation permit from the Ministry of Internal Affairs

12. Document showing the admittance to Turkish citizenship (identification registry document) for those who are foreign citizens by birth and have been admitted to Turkish Citizenship by naturalization and have dual citizenship,

13. Certified copy of the passport,

14. GCE AL certificate of TRNC citizens placed according to DEYOS exam results,

For the Turkey Scholars requested documents during the final registration are same as the documents given for the students accepted by DEYOS above except 4, 8, 11, 12 and 14. items. If it is determined that any of the statements or documents required for registration is false, the students who is registered to the university is dismissed from the university.

Instruction about the Academic Preparatory Class

The candidates who get into an education programme having a compulsory preparatory class has to take a **“Foreign Language Examination”** coordinated by the School of Foreign Languages. The candidates whose exact registrations are completed start the university as exempt from preparatory classes only if their scores is at least 55 out of 100 for the programmes whose preparatory class is optional; at least 65 out of 100 for the programmes whose education language is %100 and %30 in English or students meet the conditions of the School of Foreign Languages’ implementation fundamentals.

Re-registration

The students are obliged to re-register by discharging financial obligations determined by cabinet council within the frame of the council of ministers’ decisions, the council of higher education and the university senate to start and continue their educations and receive their diplomas in accordance with the article 16 of Law No. 2547. Fulfilment period of re-registration and financial obligations are stated on academic calendar yearly. The students who have discharged these obligations or don’t re-register without any excuse accepted by the board of relevant directors cannot continue their education.

Academic Calendar and Academic Year

Academic Calendar is determined by the university senate with the suggestion of the relevant departments. Academic year consists of fall and spring semesters and each semester lasts for 70 days except weekends and official holidays. This period contains academic and applied courses as well examinations. End of the semester /year and make-up examinations are apart from this period. If seen appropriate, classes, their examinations and field operations can be made on Saturdays with the board of relevant directors’ decision.

Study Period

Duration of study is: max. **4 years** for Associate Degree Programmes; max. **7 years** for **4-Year** Undergraduate Programmes; max. **8 years** for **5-Year** Undergraduate Programmes; max. **9 years** for **6-Year** Undergraduate Programmes.

Compulsory Attendance and its Control

Students are obliged to attend the **%70** of the academic and applied courses lectured by faculty members or instructors; the **%80** of the labs, projects, workshop and workouts performed out classes etc. in both academic sessions.

The students are regarded as absentee during their medical report and they cannot attend any courses and examinations. During this time, if the students attend classes and examinations, their exam results are regarded as invalid and they cannot attend excuse-examinations. Students can attend the courses and examinations during this time, only when they certify their good health with a new health status report.

Grading System

In our University, **Relative** and **Peremptory Grading** systems are carried out. Passing status of students can vary according to academic units.

Examinations

The students of our University are subject to relative units' principles of education and examination practice.

Objection to Examinations

Students can object to an exam result within 7 (seven) days after their proclamation date and this objection can be done only about mistakes of fact. The objection is handed to the office of the related Faculty Dean's Office or the related graduate school by a petition. If any mistake in fact is detected on exam papers, calendars or any related documents by Dean's Office or Graduate School Dean's Office, they can be corrected and announced with the board decision after related instructors' opinion is received. The students cannot object to any mistakes related instructors' grade assessments.

Academic Suspension Right

The students who suspend their education because of a legitimate and applicable excuse admitted by the related board of directors are given suspension right at once min. 1, max. 2 semesters by the related board of directors providing that they apply with permission slip and certify their excuse.

During their suspension, students cannot continue their education and all of their rights are frozen. A semester suspension right takes the time between the start of the semester and the start of the following semester.



Double Major and Minor Programmes

Double Major Programme:

The students can get another major undergraduate diploma at the same time if they carry on a major undergraduate programme with success. The students can apply for Double Major Undergraduate Programme earliest at the beginning of 3. Semester; latest at the beginning of 5. Semester for the 4-Year Undergraduate programmes, 7. Semester for the 5-Year Undergraduate programmes, 9. Semester for the 6-Year Undergraduate programmes. During the application students' all courses of major undergraduate programmes which they have attended so far must be completed successfully, grade point average must be at least **2.00/4.00** or **70/100** and they must be in the top %20 of all students. This programme consists of at least **36-Credits**. Double Major Programme is carried out in some of the departments of **Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Business, Faculty of Theology, and Faculty of Letters**.

Minor Programme:

Minor Programme aims to enable the students who carry on their major undergraduate programme with success to improve their knowledge about another department. The

students can apply for a Minor Programme earliest at the beginning of 3. Semester and latest at the beginning 6. Semester of the major undergraduate programmes. During the application period, grade point average must be at least **2.00/4.00** or **70/100**, and students' all courses of major undergraduate programmes which they have attended so far must be completed successfully. This programme consists of at least **18-Credits**. Minor Programmes are carried out in some of the departments of **Maritime Faculty, Faculty of Science, Faculty of Letters, Faculty of Engineering and Faculty of Business**. A minor programme is not an extra undergraduate programme.

International Students

Acceptance of international students is based on the results of "International Students Acceptance Examination" (DEYÖS), held at our university.

DEYÖS is in both English and Turkish languages, consists of 100 questions and test duration is 150 minutes. To be able to make a selection candidates are supposed to have at least fifty (50) score over 100 from the preferred programme score type. In addition, in order to apply for the programmes that choose students by Special Aptitude Test, candidates are supposed to have at least 30 points over 100 species (thirty) points from Social (SÖZ) score type.

Information about the admission requirements, exam, and preferences etc. for the adoption of international students are mentioned in the Dokuz Eylül University "Admission Directive for Students from Abroad".

● THE PROCESS OF ADAPTATION TO THE EUROPEAN HIGHER EDUCATION AREA

Bologna Process

The Bologna Process is a reconstruction process which aims to form a European Higher Education Area and to maintain this area by strengthening it. Through the Bologna Declaration, Bologna Process began in 1999 and the target of creating the European Higher Education Area became reality with the Budapest-Vienna Declaration of March, 2010. The first objective is to strengthen this area; to make the European Higher Education Area attractive for the students and academicians not only who live in Europe, but who come from the other continents as well. The European Higher Education Area is an area where the national higher education systems and higher education institutes join forces with each other by keeping the differences and their autonomy.

Objectives of Higher Education Institutions as a part of Bologna

- 1)** To form a higher education system which meet the economic and social needs of the society and correspond with each other.
- 2)** To increase the students' mobility and the employability of the graduates.
- 3)** To make goal-oriented collaborations such as increasing the competitive capacity of the European Higher Education System.

Within this period, the Higher Education Institution establishes a **Bologna Coordination Commission (BEK)** to structure the Bologna exercises and to provide sustainable development. Commissioners and the tasks of commission are determined by the Higher Education Institution. Accordingly, a Bologna Coordination Commission is constituted at university and pilot units are chosen. The pilot units chosen within our university are Faculty of Medicine, Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences, Faculty of Engineering, Graduate School of Social Sciences. Non-pilot units were guided to make stakeholders analysis, review and structure the instructional plans, calculate the course credits of **ECTS (European Credit Transfer System)**. Through the completion of compliance training handled within the body of our university, all university degree programs were evaluated and approved by the university senate as the date of September 2012.

Our university has leaned to “**increasing international recognition**” which is a part of core activity area of the European Higher Education Area as a priority strategical target. In this direction, it has focused on recognition of diplomas and study periods. Within this framework it aims at its objective to obtain of the **Diploma Supplement Label**. At the results of exercises conducted by all degree programmes under the Bologna Coordination Commission’s guidance, the Diploma Supplement Label application made in 2012 was found successful by the European Union Commission at the results of the evaluations carried out by the national Bologna experts team and Bologna experts at the European level. Our university became entitled to receive the Diploma Supplement Label which is an important step of international recognition.

After obtaining a Diploma Supplement Label, obtaining the European Credit Transfer System Label was set as a strategical target. The Credit Transfer System Label has the characteristics of a prize for the Higher Education Institutions, which have the Erasmus University Policy Declaration and whose degree program process complies with the Credit Transfer Systems given by the European Union Commission. The European Credit Transfer System Label application made in 2013 was found successful and deserved to earn Diploma Supplement Label through the results of the evaluations carried out by the national and international Bologna Experts.

Both Diploma Supplement Label and the European Credit Transfer System Label (ECTS) strengthen the reputation of the higher education institution having these labels in

the eye of the EU Commission and the higher education institution of the other countries, as well as they support the internationalisation of the higher education institutions.

On our website, access points were created under the titles of Bologna Process and the Diploma Supplement Label and the flow of information has been provided currently with the aim of giving information, raising awareness about the adaptation works to European Higher Education Area and gaining wide currency about the process.

European Credit Transfer System (ECTS)

ECTS is a student-centered system identified for the workload which must be achieved by the students to reach the objectives of a training program. The European Credit Transfer System is a credit saving, credit transfer, and academic accreditation system and known as a “common language” among high education area valid Europe wide.

The Objectives of European Credit Transfer System:

- 1)** To make the student mobility easier
- 2)** To guarantee the recognition of their international educations in their own countries.
- 3)** To provide rules of procedures based on student success and clearness of work programs to regulate the academic recognition
- 4)** To provide fairly mutual recognition of exchange students' courses result took in the other countries by relevant institutions.
- 5)** To provide a Europe-wide standardisation of credit and grading systems, and so to strengthen the education branch of European integration

So as to receive the European Credit Transfer System Label, our university made an application to the Center for European Union Education and Youth Program on May 31, 2013 and became entitled to receive the ECTS Label on **December 18, 2013.**

Diploma Supplement Label

The Diploma Supplement Label application of Dokuz Eylül University made in June, 2012 was found successful through the results of the evaluations carried out by the European Union Commission through the results of the evaluations carried out by the national Bologna experts team and Bologna experts at the European level. Our university became entitled to receive the International Diploma Supplement Label, which is an important step of the Bologna process in December, 2012.

Diploma Supplement certification is a form projected to provide mutual and understandable information about the diplomas and degrees in the European Higher Education Area, and a supplementary document given in addition to students' diplomas so as to support the international transparency. Diploma Supplement makes the international academic and vocational recognition of diploma degrees easier with regards to institutions and organisations.

Our University confers on all graduates comprised the individuals who have started their education by the education year 2005-2006, Diploma Supplement together with their diplomas.

What is the Diploma Supplement Label?

Diploma Supplement is a document given in addition to diplomas and defining the nature, degree, level, and status of diploma holders' education.

What Information does Diploma Supplement Label contain?

- 1) Information about the diploma holder
- 2) Descriptive information about the degree
- 3) Information about the level of degree
- 4) Information about the contents and results of the programs
- 5) Areas of diplomas' usage
- 6) Additional information
- 7) Validation of the Diploma Supplement Label
- 8) Information about the national higher education system

What benefits does Diploma Supplement Label provide students?

- 1) A diploma which can be understood and compared easily abroad.
- 2) The full definition of competence acquired during their academic career and education.
- 3) Definition of the competence and achievements objectively.
- 4) Access to work or advanced level of education opportunities easily abroad.
- 5) Encouragement of employability of the students.

Why is Diploma Supplement Label important for the Higher Education Institutes?

- 1) To increase the transparency of qualification rendering academic and professional recognition down.

- 2) To protect national/ institutive autonomy suggesting a common framework accepted in the Europe.
- 3) To provide a sound judgement of qualifications acquired, clarifying at a different education system.
- 4) To increase the institutions' recognition abroad.
- 5) To increase the employability of the graduates at a national and international level.
- 6) To save time for the administrative units of institutions while answering the frequently asked questions about the transferability and diplomas' contents by itself.

● INTERNATIONAL STUDENT COORDINATION OFFICE

The office was founded within Dokuz Eylül University International Relations Office for the orientation of international degree students who will enroll and/or international degree students who continue their education and to meet their needs in the social and cultural fields while eliminating their problems experienced in different fields. By year 2016, Dokuz Eylül University has **1.544** international degree students from 126 different countries. Among these there are 126 doctoral and 284 master students.

● STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

Erasmus +

Erasmus + is a student exchange program, which aims to exchange students, academicians, as well as staffs; to improve the education quality, and in this aspect to extend to build projects encouragingly. As part of Erasmus + Exchange Program; associate degree, undergraduate, post graduate and doctoral student can benefit from training and internship mobility; academic staff can benefit from lecturer mobility; administrative personnel can benefit from the traineeship mobility.

By year 2016, there are 338 interinstitutional agreements of Dokuz Eylul University with 27 different countries. Since 2003-2004 academic year, total 1.935 students have studied abroad and 954 students have studied at our university.

Utilisation Requirements of Erasmus + Students Mobility:

1. Students should be full-time students at our university in addition to being Turkish and/or another countries citizen.
2. Students can study abroad within the scope of this program min. **3 months** to max. **12 months**. A student can benefit from training and internship mobility for max 12 months with grant or without grant at each of the **associate degree, undergraduate degree,**

master degree or Ph.D. Degree during their whole education lives. When the 8th-semester undergraduate students have a right to benefit from internship mobility, they can exercise this right within a year following their graduation.

3. The students **must be studying** at associate degree, undergraduate degree, master degree or Ph.D. degree of formal higher education programmes, when he participates this program. Foreign language prep class, vertical transfer prep program, and adaptive program students; scientific preparatory graduate degree students; associate degree and undergraduate students in their freshman years **cannot benefit** from Erasmus + Program. (Prep year is not accepted as 1st class.)

4. Associate degree, undergraduate degree, master degree or Ph.D. degree 1st-year students can apply to Erasmus + Program with their GPA written in fall semester transcripts.

5. Grade point average (GPA) of associate degree and undergraduate students must be at least **2.20**; (GPA) of graduate students (MA, Ph.D.) must be at least **2.50** on a four-point scale. The grade conversion chart formed by the Council of Higher Education is used to be understood whether the minimum grade is provided in the departments using the 100-point grading system.

6. The students apply this program between the criteria and dates declared by the National Agency and the university through the **website of the International Relations Office**. (disciplinary punishment or lack of course from previous classes are not an obstacle for students to apply)

7. The students make a selection between the universities within the bilateral agreements of their departments.

8. The students have to certificate their language proficiency required by the institution of their choice with a language certificate obtained in last 2 years and accepted as equivalent by the Student Selection and Placement Center. The students have to take the **Foreign Language Placement Test** in case they do not have any language certificate. The foreign language level of the students so as to be evaluated is indicated through the agreements signed with the other institutions.

Mevlana Program

Mevlana Exchange Programme is a programme which allows the exchange of students and academic staff between the Turkish higher education institutions and higher education institutions of other countries and is conducted by the council of higher education.

Students may benefit abroad for the min. **1** or max **2** terms in accordance with the country and education area criteria identified by Higher Education Institution by going to institutions those who signed a bilateral Mevlana Exchange Protocol agreement with the Dokuz Eylül University. Accordingly, students from those institutions may study at the Dokuz Eylül University.

Utilisation Requirements of Mevlana Exchange Program

- 1)** The students must be studying at **associate degree, bachelor degree, master degree or Ph.D. degree** of formal higher education programmes.
- 2)** Grade point average (GPA) of associate degree and undergraduate students must be at least **2.50** on a four-point scale.
- 3)** Grade point average (GPA) of graduate students (MA, Ph.D.) must be at least **3.00** on a four-point scale.

The students studying in their first year at associate or bachelor degree and the students of preparation classes and scientific preparation programmes of graduate degrees can't participate in this program during their first semester.

Mevlana Program at our university started with the mobility performed universities in 2014-2015 academic year for the first time. In time agreements are signed with different universities and there are new existing protocols to be signed.

Farabi Program

Farabi Student and Staf Exchange Program between the Higher Education Institutions, contains students and academic staffs exchange between higher education institutions at the level of associate or undergraduate degree within the university and advanced technology institutes.

It is not an coincidence that this program is called as “Farabi” who thought that knowledge and virtue; and achieving both of them are the ways to find happiness as his all philosophy and who diversified and canalised his fund of knowledge by visiting all leading science centers. Farabi program aims to increase the information, abilities and competences of different institutions during education period.

Farabi program allows studying at the different universities and in the different cities for one or two semesters. The students, who benefit this program, gain a non-refundable scholarship for four months in the fall semester.

Utilisation Requirements of Farabi Program

1) The students must be studying at bachelor degree of formal higher education programmes.

2) Grade point average (GPA) of undergraduate students must be at least **2.00 on a four-point** scale. (Judgements of the council of higher education are taken as a basis so as to turn 100-point grading system into 4-point grading system.)

Within the scope of Farabi Program, exchange protocols were signed with 73 universities including all departments.

DISTANCE LEARNING APPLIED RESEARCH CENTER-DEUZEM

Dokuz Eylül University Distance Learning Applied Research Center (DEUZEM) conducts several training programs on the internet (deuzem.deu.edu.tr) for students who want to benefit from the advantages of education independent from time and place.

Center is conducting training activities since 2011, after it has started to perform within Dokuzçşmeler Campus since the academic year of 2012-2013. Language Research and Teaching Center – DEDAM

Dokuz Eylul University Language Research and Teaching Center (DEDAM) is a language research, practice and teaching center founded by Dokuz Eylul University with the aim of doing language researches and language teaching. DEDAM's primary aim is to teach Turkish as a foreign language and research on Turkish.

DEDAM, the first language training and research center to be founded within the structure of Dokuz Eylul University, aspires to serve teaching primarily Turkish and other languages as well, with an authentic and an innovative approach.

DEDAM aims to make Turkey, the international center of attraction for Turkish and other languages teaching and also modern language research. For this purpose, DEDAM instructs language courses and runs projects in the fields of linguistics and language teaching.

Scope:

1. Teaching Turkish as a foreign language and other modern languages.
2. Doing theoretic and practical studies, also running projects in the fields of linguistics, Turkish and foreign language teaching.
3. Publishing books, academic journals and brochures of the theoretic and practical studies in linguistics, Turkish and foreign language teaching.
4. In accordance with the language center's aims and area of activities, organizing and participating in symposiums, congresses and courses and following the developments in the field.
5. Providing students and academicians and people who are studying linguistics, Turkish and foreign language teaching with a practice area.
6. Researching language teaching approaches and methods and preparing materials, also publishing books and academic journals for the purpose of making widely known in Turkey and abroad.
7. Establishing branch offices in Turkey and abroad to introduce Turkey, Turkish culture and Turkish language according to the legislation provisions.
8. Providing agencies and institutes with consultancy service and in-service training in Turkey and abroad.
9. Exchanging students and academicians between agencies and institutions in Turkey and abroad and also having joint academic studies.
10. Educating and providing a practice area for students who have the appropriate bachelor degree. Also certifying their practical studies in the language center.
11. Holding language examinations in accordance with the demand of agencies, institutions and individuals, certifying their exam results.
12. Supporting scientific and formal studies, providing translation service in accordance with the demands of the agencies and institutions.

Courses

Turkish as a foreign language, English, German, French, Italian, Japanese, Greek, Spanish, Russian and Ottoman Turkish courses are arranged for different levels in several times a year. Courses in other languages can be organized on-demand.

A curriculum which supports intercultural communication and improves the four basic language skills; listening, reading, speaking and writing is applied in DEDAM.

All students that participate in courses can certify that they attended the course. Certificates are issued for students who successfully complete the courses in general language courses. DEDAM certificate is acknowledged by the Council of Higher Education and Dokuz Eylul University affiliated universities (in Europe).

Language courses consist of five level: A1 and A2 (beginner), B1 and B2 (intermediate), and C1 (advanced). Course levels are determined according to European Language Portfolio. A placement test is applied to the new students who register for the courses and these students are placed to the appropriate levels according to the results of this exam. A curriculum which supports intercultural communication and improves the four basic language skills; listening, reading, speaking and writing is applied in DEDAM.

Course materials for Turkish as a foreign language, prepared as projects by DEDAM instructors, are used in lessons. A1 and A2 level materials were collected into a book and published as “İzmir Yabancılar için Türkçe”.

In addition to lessons, excursions, movie screenings, group readings and interpretation activities are held for students to learn more about Turkish culture.

In addition to general language courses, lessons and test practice events are held for YDS and proficiency exams. Courses in other languages can be organized on-demand. All national and international students can participate to courses.

Special clause of adhesion, application document and fees can be seen on course announcement if available.

About Exams

Placement test and certificate exams can be held in DEDAM. Certificate exams are held for students who are participating in courses, at the end of every level and also for those who need certificate. Certificate is certified by principal of DEDAM and Dokuz Eylul University Rector.

Certificates are issued at least 15 days after the exam. Placement tests are held for those who want to participate DEDAM courses or want to learn their levels. Document, certified by principal of DEDAM is issued after the exam.

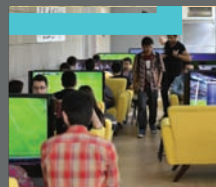

● FOOD SERVICES

There are 6 kitchens affiliated with Department of Health, Culture and Sports that make food. We have a total number of 27 dining halls, which include 8 student dining halls, 6 staff dining halls, and 13 common dining halls and at these dining halls 9.350 people are served lunch, students who attend evening school are served dinner and three meals both on weekdays and weekends are provided at DEU Student Dormitory. Also, food services at Schools, Vocational Schools and Faculties located out of Izmir, in Torbalı, Seferihisar, Urla, Foça, and Bergama districts are given. Menus are prepared by kitchen staff and checked by dietitians according to daily calorie intakes our students need. Our kitchens offer four different foods at every meal.

Our students can use the virtual money that they have loaded onto their Smart Cards for daily or weekly food services between 11:45-14:00 at dining halls affiliated with our University given below. 24 canteen-cafeterias that are affiliated with the Head of Department of Health, Culture and Sports and two grocery stores as well as numerous private canteens offer our staff and students fast food, cold and hot drinks, and ready-to-eat food.

Within one month after you enter Turkey you must apply for your Residence Permit at the Republic of Turkey Ministry of Interior Directorate Provincial Migration Management (T.C. İçişleri Bakanlığı Göç İdaresi, İzmir İl Müdürlüğü) Do not wait too long to schedule an online appointment because available dates are limited. We strongly recommend you schedule this appointment on your first day of arrival.

According to new regulation, all international students must obtain a Health Insurance that is valid in Turkey to be able to receive the residence permit.

DEPART was founded in 2013. DEPART is consisted of **DEPART Olive Building (Zeytin Binası)** and **Pomegranate Units (Nar Üniteleri)** in the Inciraltı Campus; and **ALPHA** and **BETA** Buildings in the Tinaztepe Campus. According to the evaluation of Turkish Ministry of Science, Industry and Technology by 42 criteria, with the first year-performance data, DEPART was the first among early level technology parks of Turkey. Moreover, it has been the 7th best park in Turkey although it was founded as number 35th.

- Our students have job and **internship opportunities** in more than 100 companies of DEPART, whose number is also increasing day by day.
- Our students who would like to develop technology and conduct R&D and innovation activities by **founding their own companies** can improve their projects by presenting their

projects in the pre-incubator and incubator offices at DEPARK;

- Our students can found their own companies at DEPARK with technopark advantages **if their business ideas come into reality as a company.**
- Our students **have opportunity to get financial support for their projects** and get prizes by following DEPARK activities closely and by participating to project marathons (Hackathon), national and international activities (Global Game Jam, Fishackathon etc.)
- Our students **can access to the financing which they need for their business ideas** by meeting angel investors and funders through DEPARK.

In the DEPARK Tinaztepe Campus, beside innovator companies of all sizes in sectors of Software, Informatics, Electronics, advanced material technology, Design, Nanotechnology, Automotive, Renewable Energy and Textile etc. there are also international companies such as Ericsson whose global R&D centers have carried to Izmir and DEPARK.

DEPARK-Health in the Inciralti Campus is also the first health technologies-themed technopark in Turkey. In this ecosystem supporting this theme, experienced University Hospital, the biggest Biomedical R&D in Turkey, Medical Faculty, Graduate School of Health Sciences, Vocational Schools of Health, Health Technology Accelerator form the definition of Ideal Health Innovation Zone.

Improving R&D cooperation between University and Industry at regional, national and international levels, particularly in Izmir, DETTO have the task to support

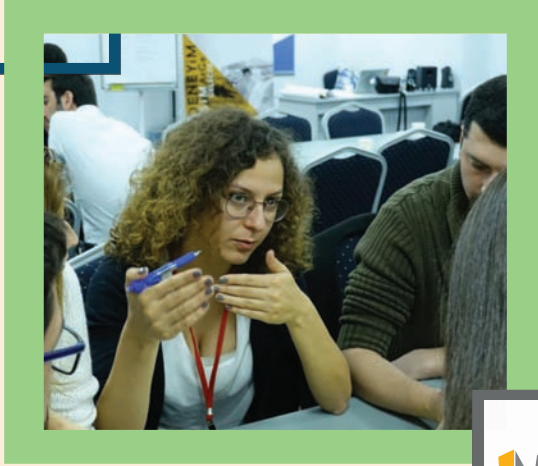

Izmir International Biomedicine & Genome Institute - IBG-IZMIR

Major aims of Izmir International Biomedicine and Genome Institute (IBG-IZMIR) are to raise people's wealth level by contributing effectively to acceleration of scientific discoveries; to contribute to solution of general health and science problems of global development by creating therapeutic cells, cost-effective biosimilar and new approaches in vaccine development; to conduct common activities by getting into innovator partnership with shareholders at national and global levels; to develop innovator technologies, tools and services for prevention, diagnosis and treatment of global health problems such as cancer, obesity, infectious, neurologic and degenerative diseases.

Izmir International Biomedicine and Genome Institute (IBG-IZMIR) was founded within "Biolzmir" Science and Technology Park as the innovator partnership of DEU Health Campus, Medical Faculty, University Hospital and Health Techno Park (DEPARK) by name of "International Biomedicine and Genome Institute Project".

The institute whose aim is to be a perfection center providing services for society health, economic welfare and for people benefit with its medical discoveries and R&D activities was approved as "DEU Izmir Biomedicine and Genome Practice and Research Center" in the official gazette in September of 2014.

After Izmir International Biomedicine and Genome Institute were approved by The Council of Higher Education in 2015 and DEU Izmir Biomedicine and Genome Practice and Research Center was linked to the institute, our institute has been awarded an education, practice and research corporate identity.

IBG-Izmir has **22.250** m² indoor areas in which there are facilities with responsible researcher labs and offices, cell culture labs, equipped rooms for common use, conference hall, seminar, meeting and rest rooms. Our center has central research opportunities, some of which are still under development. The greatest one of these central opportunities is laboratory animal facility (Vivarium) with capacity of 20.000 animals whose area is **3.500** m². Other central service facilities spread on a **3.100** m² area.

Working Areas

IBG-Izmir has an extensive work area with so many science fields such as molecular biology, genetics, medicine, pharmaceuticals bioengineering and computer engineering. The institute was founded in Izmir which is one of the most significant locomotives in the field of health for Turkish economy and it is the first research center within this scope.

Criteria and Opportunities for National and International Students

Foundation of “Genomics and Molecular Biotechnology” Department and “Biomedicine and Health Technologies” Department in the institute was approved in May of 2015 by The Council of Higher Education. Planning to open English master programs, our institute provides now opportunity for students to do internship at bachelor and master degrees.

IBG-Izmir provides qualified biomedicine trainings for medical personnel, students and worldwide visitors; on the other hand, it creates unique opportunities for distinguished, skilled and young science people to convert their basic scientific researches into innovation; to produce therapeutic cells, cost-effective biosimilar and vaccines; and to contribute to welfare of local and regional population.

In case the international students do not submit a written application to our Institution for universal health insurance within three months following their enrollment at school, they cannot be registered under universal health insurance during their study."

Sabancı Culture Palace

Sabancı Culture Palace, which was built on the land allocated by the DEU Rectorate and Izmir Governorship as well as with contributions from Sabancı Foundation, was established in one indoor complex of 5.000 m² with two main divisions.

The first division has **Hasan Tahsin Hall** with a capacity of **538**. The hall is suitable for any kind of artistic and cultural performance such as theatrical plays, operas, ballets, concerts and exhibitions to take place with its stage and foyer. It has a folding orchestra pit, 250 m² stage area, and its stage dimension is 12x16m². It has all facilities including a freight lift connected to the stage and a 6x8 cinevision curtain for various shows such as musicals and plays who are huge in number.

The second division has **Yüzbaşı Şerafettin Hall** with a capacity of **123**. This hall serves with a stage area of 75 m², acoustic architecture, and impressive lightning equipment.

Special classrooms for the ballet department of the conservatory, study rooms, 4 ballet studios, and rooms of administrative and academic staff are also in the



complex. Each studio has a piano.

The Sabancı Culture Palace, whose location is very easily accessible both from the sea and land, gives the conservatory students an opportunity to study in a modern environment.

The entrance foyer, the third floor and fourth floor foyers are used for exhibitions. Moreover, the Palace has the capacity to host all cultural and artistic events including theatrical plays by known theatre groups, various panel discussions, and other special events.

Loading Weekly Credit onto DEU SmartCard

Credits can be loaded at loading points and kiosks in exchange of cash and you can turn your credit into "weekly food" at loading points and kiosks. If the card holder wants to use their card for one meal, they can use the card from "daily food" price after they have loaded credit onto their cards.

The stolen smart card is made blocked. When this application is not made, the holder is responsible from any consequences resulting from stealing.

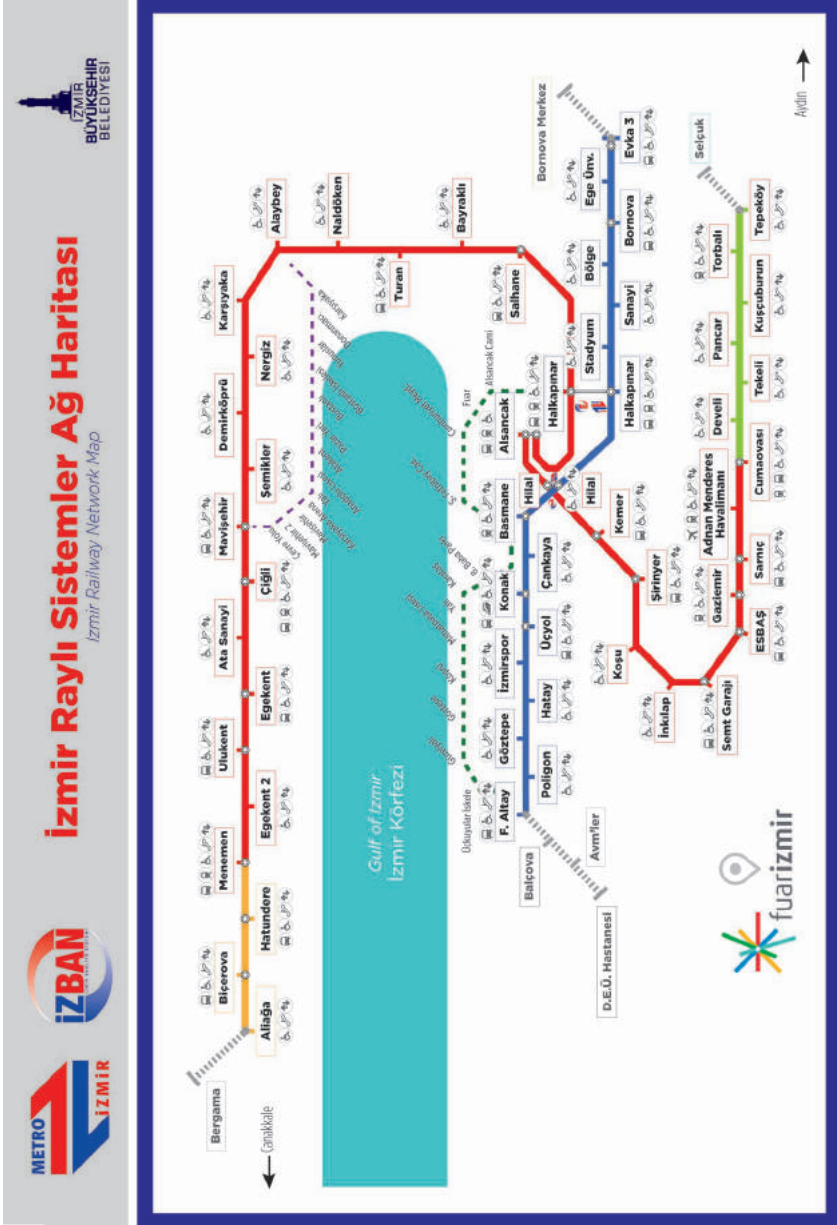

HISTORICAL AND TOURISTIC PLACES TO VISIT IN IZMIR

Izmir, the third largest city in Turkey, is a city that has preserved its importance in all ages with its mild climate, natural habitat and historic centers surrounding the city. Izmir, with its second largest port of Turkey after Istanbul, contains Ephesus that is among the most important ancient cities and one of the biggest cities of the world during the Roman ages as well as tourist attraction centres such as Çeşme and Foça.

The length of natural beaches of Izmir are 101 kilometres and Izmir has a total coastline of 629 kilometres. The coastline is also suitable for water sports thanks to its peninsulas and bays. Travelling to beaches is very easy and there are many sight-seeing areas in the city.

Places to visit in Izmir Province

Kemeraltı Bazaar – Konak

Kemeraltı Bazaar is the most important market in Izmir. It hosts modern-day stores, cinemas as well as historical stores where any kind of goods can be found for shopping. Kızlarağası Hani, the biggest inn in Izmir, is located inside Kemeraltı Bazaar and Izmir Clock Tower is located on the square where entrance to the Bazaar is also at.

Alsancak

Alsancak is a lively place which you can visit any time around the clock. There are

numerous restaurants, cafés, and places of entertainment in Alsancak. You can also take a walk along the waterfront. Alsancak has preserved its status as an entertainment center for students for years.

Agora

Agora, located in Namazgâh neighbourhood of Izmir, dates back to 2nd century A.D. Roman times and was built as a three storey edifice close to the city center according to the Hippodamos urban plan. The Izmir Agora is the biggest and well preserved among ionic agoras. Poseidon, Demeter and Artemis Statues, which were discovered during excavations that began in 1927, are on the display at Izmir Archeological Museum. Archeological excavations that speeded up in 1996 are going on as restoration, archeological cleaning and landscaping with the sponsorship of Izmir Metropolitan Municipality.

Karşıyaka

One of the most sight-seeing areas in Izmir, Karşıyaka is top on the list with its shops, restaurants and other opportunities for shopping. You can go to Karşıyaka easily by Ferry from Alsancak, Konak and Pasaport.

Buca – Gölet (Pond)

There are many restaurants and cafés at Gölet which is founded on 140.000 m2. During summertime, Gölet hosts cultural and arts events and has amphitheatre, picnic area, allotment gardens, viewing platform and a market.

Bornova Büyük and Küçük Park (Small and Big Park Neighbourhoods)

You can go to either of these neighbourhoods by Izmir Metro where you can find many cafés that mostly serve students.

Asansör was constructed by Nesim Levi to make it easier for people who want to go to upper parts of Mithatpaşa neighbourhood and it is one of the most important edifices in the city. During the 1930's, Asansör had a theatre, a cinema, and a photographer's shop, today it has become a cultural complex. You can eat at Asansör with a wonderful view of Izmir.

Kadifekale (lit. The Velvet Hill)

Situated on a hill overlooking the city, the castle has traces of Hellenistic, Roman, and Byzantine eras. Today it is a famous tourist attraction site with its tea gardens and wonderful view of the city.



Kuş Cenneti (Bird Sanctuary)

The Bird Sanctuary that has millions of birds of 190 different bird genera with its islands, reeds, and plains is a must on the list as a wonderful 8 thousand hectare wildlife park under protection just by the city.

İzmir Doğal Yaşam Parkı (Izmir Wild Life Park)

Founded on an area of 425.000 m², Izmir Wild Life Park gives visitors the opportunity to see wild animals in their natural habitat at Çiğli Sasalı. Visitors can also visit bird observation towers, coppice forests, and recreation areas.

Balçova Kaplıcaları (Balçova Thermal Spring)

Known in ancient times as Agememnon Thermal Spring, Balçova Thermal Spring is located 10 kilometres west of Izmir. Balçova Thermal Spring is one of the biggest in Turkey.

İnciraltı

Being the largest recreational area and green field in Izmir, Inciraltı is an amazing place with many tea gardens and esplanades.



Kültürpark

Kültürpark, one of the greenest fields in the city, is primarily a recreational area with palm trees, sports and entertainment facilities. Kültürpark hosted Izmir International Fairs that took place between 1936 - 2014. Gathering places and activity centres at Kültürpark include: Atatürk Outdoor Theatre, İsmet İnönü Art Center, Izmir Art, Parachute Tower, Celal Atik Gym, Amusement Park, Youth Theatre, Painting and Sculpture Museum, History and Art Museum.

Teleferik

Teleferik is a picnic area in Balçova which is accessible by bus that goes to Balçova every 10 minutes. After a three minute journey on the aerial tramway viewing the city, visitors reach the hilltop where facilities are placed on. Visitors who wish to make their own barbecue can buy meat from self-catering area, and there are also restaurants that offer traditional tastes. You can have a picnic with your family on the hilltop overlooking the city.



Places To Visit Around Izmir

Efes / Selçuk

Selçuk that is home to Ephesus, an ancient city known worldwide, is historically rich. Selçuk Keçi Kalesi (Goat Fortress) and Basilica of St. John are among the important historic sites. Belevi Mausoleum, Aqueduct ruins, İsa Bey Mosque are must-visit historical places. Of all the many ancient cities in Turkey,

Ephesus is the most impressive and most famous city. The city was built in 1000 BC and served as the Roman capital in Asia. The first city to be built thoroughly with marble, Ephesus is a very important city for Christianity. It is believed that the Bible was written in Ephesus and it is believed that Mary the Virgin died here. The most important parts of Ephesus are a theatre with a capacity of 24.000 people, the biggest example of the ancient times, Artemis Temple, one of the seven wonders of the world, and Library of Celsus.

Torbali

There are ruins of Metropolis ancient city in the Torbali district which is 45 kilometres away from Izmir.



Seferihisar

Aside from its historical richness dating back to the 3rd millenia BCE, Seferihisar draws attention in the Aegean region with its castle built in the middle ages and the settlement area within the castle, historical celebration areas, beaches, mosque, Turkish baths, Sığacık vocation district and Teos Ancient City site. Seferihisar is 47 kilometers away from the city center.

Bergama

Located 100 kilometers north of Izmir, Bergama takes its name from the ancient name during the ancient times, Pergamon and is one of the oldest settlements in Anatolia. The region hosts historical sites that have worldwide importance.

Çeşme

Only 80 kilometers away from the city centre, Çeşme is one of the popular vacation destinations with its beaches, bays and turquoise blue sea. There are many beaches along the indented coastline. Summer houses, hotels, and hostels expand along the coastline from Alaçatı in the south to Ildır in the north. This makes Çeşme a resort that mainly hosts tourists.



Foça

Founded on a peninsula between Çandarlı and İzmir bays, Foça has been declared as “Special Environmental Protection Area” in order to protect its archeological and architectural richness as well as the natural environment.

Karaburun

Karaburun, which has a blue flag, is one of the worth-seeing touristic destinations with its mediterranean monk seals and narcissuses as well as natural beauty.

Kuşadası

Kuşadası is one of the oldest and most attractive tourism areas in Turkey with its sun, sea, historical assets and its marina at international levels. Due to its closeness to religious and cultural centers such as Selçuk, Ephesus, and Virgin Mary, this popular area has become one of Turkey’s tourism centers.

Şirince

Şirince is located on a hillside surrounded with its vineyards, peach gardens, and olive groves 8 kilometers east of Selçuk district.

Urla

Urla, which is located 38 kilometres away from İzmir, is a fishing heaven and offers a variety of dishes peculiar to the region.

İzmir Universities Platform

İzmir Universities Platform that is formed by six universities that are going on their educational activities, is constituted in December 2008.

Aiming cooperation of the universities in İzmir both in academic and social and also in cultural and sportive areas, the Platform brings together the six universities Ege University, Dokuz Eylül University, İzmir Institute of Technology, İzmir Economy University, Yaşar University and İzmir Kâtip Çelebi University.

Besides “İzmir Festival of Universities” in the first term, “Agora Cup” in second and third terms and “İzmir Universities Platform Events” organized annually till fourth term; the platform also carries out organizations in order to produce a solution in deployment of resources by putting such projects in its agenda as conducting mutual scientific studies of the students of six member universities, applying student and lecturer exchange programs among the universities and especially contributing to the city in the issues regarding students and universities with the cooperation of local authorities, central



authorities, trade associations, non-governmental organizations and other institutions and organizations.

In the second term an International Education Institution is formed within the scope of positioning Izmir as the city of the universities - which is also the aim of the platform itself- and internationalizing the Izmir Universities. This board gets into the act in accordance with the main theme "Study in Izmir".

Moreover, the panel “İzmir in Universities’ Opinion” with the participation of all rectors of platform’s member universities and the panel “Turkey Economic Policies in Economy Students’ Opinion” with the participation of a student from each universities studying economy are arranged.

Defining the main theme as “The City of International Universities - İzmir” for the seventh term, “1. International Students’ Day” is organized in the beginning of the term with the participation of international students of platform’s six member universities.

In the eight term with expanding cooperation together with national and international institutions and organizations, “Applied Training of Project Writing” for nongovernmental organizations is arranged with the cooperation of Governorship Of İzmir and Provincial Directorate Of Associations regarding the theme “Haydi Proje Yapalım (Let’s Make Project)”. Applying the rotating presidency system in the platform, the Rektor of Ege University Prof.Dr. Candeğer Yılmaz in the first term; the former Rektor of İzmir Economy University Prof.Dr. Attila Sezgin in the second term, the Rektor of Dokuz Eylül University Prof. Dr. Mehmet Füzün in the third term, the former Rektor of Yaşar University Prof. Dr. Murat Barkan, the Rektor of İzmir Institute of Technology Prof. Dr. Mustafa Güden in the fifth term, the Rektor of Gediz University Prof. Dr. Seyfullah Çevik in the sixth term and the Rektor of İzmir Kâtip Çelebi University Prof. Dr. Galip Akhan have taken up the position of presidency. In the eight term the Rektor of İzmir University Prof. Dr. Kayhan Erciyes has taken over the position. Since the foundation, general coordinatorship of the platform is performed by Asst. Prof. Cengiz Üzün DEU - the Coordinator of Corporate Cooperation and Intercollegiate Communications.

İzmir Universities Platform consists of four fundamental bodies. These bodies; **Executive Committee** which is the top committee of the platform and consisting of the rectors of the universities who had generated the platform, **Sub-Working**
